§ 87-1. Short title.

This chapter shall be known as the “Bingo Licensing Law of the Village of Barker.”

§ 87-2. Application of chapter.

It shall be lawful for any authorized organization, upon obtaining the required license therefor, to conduct the game of bingo within the territorial limits of the Village of Barker, subject to the provisions of this chapter, the provisions of Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law (known as the “Bingo Licensing Law”), the provisions of Article 19-B of the Executive Law (known as the “Bingo Control Law”).

§ 87-3. Referendum; when effective.

This chapter shall be submitted for the approval of the electors of the Village of Barker at a special election, and shall take effect after approval by a majority of the qualified electors of the Village of Barker voting thereon,¹ and upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York and with the State Racing and Wagering Board.

§ 87-4. Conduct of games on Sunday.

[Added 12-6-1982 by L.L. No. 4-1982]

The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license authorizing the holding, operating and conducting of bingo on Sunday, subject to the provisions of Local Law No. 2 of the year 1982, the provisions of Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law (known as the "Bingo Licensing Law"), and the provisions of Article 19-B of the Executive Law (known as the "Bingo Control Law").
