## **PUBLIC WORKS REPORT** March 2024

### **Streets:**

- Plowed and salted streets, old and new village halls, and garage area
- Swept up debris in the street at Quaker Road and Coleman Road
- Fixed reflectors on rubber bumpers in front of the village hall on Main Street
- Met with HyTech Concrete – quotes on sidewalks

### **Water:**

- Town capped off sewer line and cut and capped water service from curb box for Yorker House demo
- Located and marked curb boxes – High Street, East Avenue, Church Street, and Woodward Avenue
- Met with Kevin Miller- rural water leak detection - went around village listening to hydrants, valves, and curb boxes - correlated spot-possible leak on services to main line -East Avenue
- Wrote measurements in book – curb boxes High Street and East Avenue
- Final water reading at 8711 High Street – house sold
- With LNR Industries – digging and locating – sewer lateral, water main and two services for 1880 and 1881 East Avenue – no leak found on either service – filled back in
- Met with leak detection again – went around listening and correlating on main valves – got done with Quaker Road from Haight Road to Main Street, Main Street, around Mayer Brothers and Church Street from Quaker Road to Pallister Avenue – found no leaks
- Read meters for the quarter

### **Equipment:**

- Greased mowing deck and installed deck to tractor
- Picked up battery at Napa in Newfane – installed new battery in B2601 tractor
- Installed new lights on trailer
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Rinsed out salter

### **Parks:**

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Raked and picked up branches in village park
- Fixed flagpole rope – hung up new flag – village park
- Picked up branches and cut plants down at lake park
- Opened gate valve in skating rink – drain water out
