PUBLIC WORKS REPORT June 2023

Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall area and garage area
- Picked up cold patch and filled potholes in streets
- Trimmed bush on corner of Quaker Road and Church Street
- Weeded and sprayed for weeds along north curb and sidewalk on Main Street
- Removed handicap signs and bases – scrapped and painted bases yellow
- Got dump truck and chipper ready – went around and chipped brush
- Cut low hanging branches on corners of East Avenue and Coleman Road – east and west sides – blocking traffic views
- Removed and leveled dirt and stump grindings from two trees taken down on Main Street
- Cut small trees growing along railing on Quaker Road (above creek)

Water:

- Backflow inspections at 8680 Church Street and 1875 Quaker Road
- Town disconnected sewer, helped dig water service and disconnected at 8736 Main Street
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Washed trucks and tractors
- Took tail gate off of dump truck to pick up cold patch
- Turned in specs for new dump truck and going out to bid
- Greased fittings on mower deck
- Jump started police Tahoe and moved it to a different area at garage – tow truck coming to pick it up

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Watered plants in village park
- Finished mulch at lake park
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Sprinkled preen around trees and flowers in parks
- Cut down small pine trees in village park
- Replaced outlet cover in gazebo that was broken by kids
- Sprayed for weeds – around trees, brick sidewalks and gazebo in village park

Other:

- Laid out walls and made chalk lines on floor at new village hall
- Picked up supplies at Stockham Lumber
- Finished weeding around village and started spraying for weeds
- Wrote monthly reports
- Board meeting
- Filled in potholes in driveway to garage with stone
