## **PUBLIC WORKS REPORT** April 2024

### **Streets:**

- Met with Barton and Loguidice – storm drains- went around village checking out areas where drains were located, direction they flowed and areas of flooding concerns
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall and garage areas
- Weeded around all signs and hydrants in the village

### **Water:**

- Finished reading water meters for the quarter
- Spent a day with Kevin Miller (leak detection), checked every street going to main valve. Took measurements and correlated to see if it showed any signs of leaks.
- Tested water that was coming up from the ground at 1714 Pallister Avenue – test was negative for chlorine and fluoride

### **Equipment:**

- Disconnected wiring to salter – Town unloaded salter with backhoe, installed back gate to dump body, sprayed dump body with diesel and greased fittings
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Greased mowing deck

### **Parks:**

- Raked, picked up branches, weeded, and mowed both parks
- Village Park – restacked pavers around flagpole, lion sign, and memorial
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Worked up dirt in flower beds in village park

### **Other:**

- Loaded up shelving in metal building – took over to new village hall – put together shelving and placed in fireproof room
- Went to Harbor Freight to pick up supplies
- Went to Stockham Lumber and picked up 18 80 pound bags of concrete mix for flag pole
