Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, shoveled and salted sidewalk around village hall, plowed and salted parking lot, East Avenue property and garage parking lot
- Cleaned up edges of streets – dirt from plowing – section of High Street and Pallister Avenue

Water:

- Shut water off at curb box at 1667 Quake Road – no one living there
- Worked on locating and fixing water leak – service to 8700 High Street – help from Town water department and LNR Industries – service had two large holes in copper line – cut and replaced section of copper line
- Shut water off at curb box at 1723 Quaker Road
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Installed bracket underneath tractor for snowplow
- Rinsed off dump truck and salter
- Installed rubber mat on back of dump truck bumper – protect it from salt
- Washed and detailed interior of old dump truck, installed plow and old salter – getting ready for auction
- Met with Dave from auction – took pictures of dump truck and pickup truck – dump truck going up for auction January 7-14th
- Installed cab, bracket, and snowplow to B2601 tractor
- Washed and detailed interior on pickup truck

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Decorated gazebo and bushes in village for Light up Barker

Other:
