PUBLIC WORKS REPORT January 2025

Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, village hall parking lot, garage parking lot and East Avenue property – shoveled and salted sidewalk around village hall
- Pushed back piles of snow at street intersections, village hall parking lot and dead end of Pallister Avenue and Woodward Avenue
- Removed piles of snow on sidewalk north of Main Street
- Ordered rock salt from American Rock Salt – three trucks delivered salt for the month of January (67.99 tons)

Water:

- Four dig requests – three on Main Street – removing old power poles and one on Haight Road – out of village – poles were clear from water
- Located and shut off water at 8697 Church Street – owner needs to replace shut off inside the house
- Called county water department – said our water use is right where it needs to be – water loss is down

Equipment:

- New pickup truck was delivered from Basil Chevrolet – 2025
- 2012 dump truck went up for auction – high bid was \$24,000.00
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Rinsed out salter on dump truck
- Installed new signs on both trucks made by Mark Welds
- Oil and filter changed on pickup truck at Hartway Motors, picked up power steering fluid

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Picked up branches in both parks
- Took down Christmas tree, lights and garland on gazebo in village park, packed away and stored in metal building

Other:

- Board Meeting
- Wrote monthly reports
- Placed flags at village hall and park at half staff for Jimmy Carter until January 28th
- Went to Rubber Farm in Lockport to pick up rubber bases for new parking signs at village hall
- Went to Niagara County sign shop – design and make parking signs at village hall
