Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, garage area and village hall area
- Watered plants along Main Street
- Weeded around signs, intersections, hydrants and ditches along Quaker Road, Coleman Road, and West Somerset Road
- Sprayed for weeds along ditch in front of Dollar General and sidewalk along Main Street
- Readied chipper and dump truck – chipped brush for the last time for the summer
- Pulled plants and removed barrels along Main Street and stored away

Water:

- Dig request at school property – several borings for repaving parking lots – located and marked water mains
- Backflow inspection at 8685 Coleman Road
- Shut water off in meter pit for 1695 East Avenue

Equipment:

- Changed oil and filters in dump truck and pickup truck
- Washed both trucks
- Tested batteries in pickup truck – one of the batteries had trouble starting and was replaced
- Washed and removed decals from police car – getting ready for auction
- Dave Brooks from RTI Auction stopped by and took pictures and pin information of police car – car up for auction November 3rd

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded both parks

- Cut down plants around sign in lake park
