Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall and around garage area
- Pulled out a piece of rebar sticking up along sidewalk at Quaker Rd & Coleman Rd.

Water:

- Had the water tested for lead again at 8690 Coleman Rd. Took the sample to Niagara Falls lab to be tested. Reading was 4.42 ug/L – last reading was 7/23/2020, 15.60 ug/L. The reading from 3 years ago was 6.59 ug/L.
- Turned water on at 1715 Quaker Rd.
- Helped the town water department with a water leak on County Line Rd.

Equipment:

- Mounted brackets onto the B2301 tractor and hooked up the mowing deck and greased the fittings on the mower deck.
- Washed plow on dump truck, took plow off and stored away in the metal building.
- Got the chipper out and hooked up to the battery, changed oil and filter, and changed the blades.
- Gordon Fisk's - took the blades for the chipper to be sharpened and dropped off the saw to be repaired.
- Washed the salter, sprayed rust and corrosion protection on chains and fittings on the salter. Took the salter off the dump truck, stored away outside.
- Took sandbags out of the back of the pickup truck.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks weekly
- Opened gate valve to the skating rink to drain the water.
- Mowed and weed eaten both parks.

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Attended board meeting
- Cut and removed a large branch that fell behind the garage.
