Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall property and public works area.
- Chipped brush around the village.
- Replaced a stolen stop sign at the corner of Hight St. and East Ave. Both the street and stop signs for that intersection were stolen last month.

• Ordered the street signs and stop signs from the County Highway Dept for High St. and East Ave.

Water:

- Two dig requests submitted for 1719 East Ave. and 8520 W Somerset Rd. Located and marked water.
- Final water read at 8676 Coleman Rd.- The house was sold.

Equipment:

- Disconnected wires to salter and spreader and greased the fittings. The Town came over with a backhoe and lifted the salter off of the dump truck. The salter was put on pallets outside and covered with a tarp for storage.
- Installed tailgate onto dump truck.
- Took plow off the dump truck and stored for the summer.
- Washed both trucks.
- Installed side panels and mesh top on to dump truck.
- Pulled the chipper out of the metal building, hooked up battery and checked the gas and oil. Got the chipper running.

<u>Parks:</u>
