Streets:

- Watered plants along Main St
- Chipped Brush
- Took down wooden fence at dead end of Woodward Ave
- Took down faded no parking signs
- Wrote down number of light poles that were out, turned into Village hall to be called in to be fixed
- Removed weeds and dirt along North side of Main St curb
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, Village Hall, and garage area
- Weed eated old Village hall site, around hydrants, street signs.
- Hornets nest on Main St was taken care of by Cummings Pest Solutions out of Gasport, in front of 8703 Main St.
- Went to Niagara County Sign Dept, new sign warning Semi Trucks not to use Main St.

Water:

- THM and HAA Water testing, samples from The Commons, 1889 Quaker Rd. Took samples to Niagara Falls lab to be tested.
- Installed water meter in meter pit for 1 ½' water service to 1695 East Ave.
- Took water sample at 1693 Quaker Rd for asbestos, done every 11 years. Took sample to EM55 Analytical to be tested.
- Dig request AT 8671 Main St. Water was clear from work being done.

Equipment:

- Changed transmission and hydraulic fluids and filters in the Kabota B2301 Tractor
- Dropped off chains for chainsaws to Gordon Fisks
- Cleaned underneath mowing deck and changed blades on mower
- Washed tractors and trucks
