Streets:

- Water plants along Main St
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall and around garage area
- Sprayed for weeds:
 - Coleman Rd, Ditch, North side by Village welcome sign.
 - North side of Main St
- Went around village weed eaten around hydrants and signposts
- Chipped Brush

Water:

- THM & HAA Water Testing – Took water samples at the Commons, 1895 Quaker Rd. Took the samples to Niagara Falls lab to be tested.
- Dig request at 1707 Quaker Rd – located & marked water main & service.
- Backflow inspection at: 1876 Quaker Rd, 8688 Coleman (No backflow) & 1719 East Ave
- Checked the water meter at 8719 Main St, is working fine.

Equipment:

- Washed both trucks and tractors.
- Changed the blades on mowing deck, took dull blades to Gordon Fisk to be sharpened.
- Drum Oil picked up new gauge for gas tank

Parks:

- Water plants in the Village Park daily
- Mowed and weed eaten both parks.
