Streets:

- Plowed & salted streets, garage parking lot and East Ave extension to the Village Hall/Police Station
- Shoveled and Salted steps in front of Village Hall
- Called and had Niagara County sign Dept install new posts and signs on Quaker Rd where a car had run
 over the post and sign across from the school. School and Speed Limit signs
- Pushed back snow piles at the intersections, garage parking lot and village hall.
- Removed snow piles along northside of Main St sidewalks and pushed back south side of Main St.
- Snowblower used for the sidewalks.

Water:

- THM & HAA tests. Took water samples from the Barker Commons located at 1889 Quaker Rd, to Niagara Falls Lab to be tested
- Shut off the water at 1715 Quaker Road curb box
- Had phase 1 & 2 of the water projects, showing Hydrant locations, sent to Joe from ISO

Equipment:

- Greased the fittings on the salter and the dump truck
- Took dump truck to Heinrich Chevrolet.
 - Wipers, Squirters, back flashing lights and salter not working
 - Main fuse was blown, had to disconnect the back flashers due to the switch causing the fuse to blow
- Disinfected the dump truck and both tractors

Parks:

- Shoveled the sidewalk in front of the gazebo, steps, and floor of gazebo. There was wedding that Friday afternoon.
- Filled the skating rink with water.
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks weekly

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
