Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall and around garage area
- Water plants along Main St
- Filled in potholes with cold patch.
- Weed eaten and sprayed for weeds
 - along the railing at the creek on Quaker Rd next to the firehall.
 - the curb and sidewalk on North and South of Main St. Trimmed low branches and sprayed for weeds.
 - The ditch on Quaker Rd in front of Dollar General
- Installed side boards and top mesh onto dump truck hooked up chipper and chipped brush around the village.
