PUBLIC WORKS REPORT July 2017

Streets:

- Mowed road sides, ditches, garage area and East Ave. property
- Watered plants along Main St. and gazebo
- Chipped brush
- Trimmed around streets signs and hydrants
- Replaced broken flag poles, ripped and faded flags on Quaker Rd. and Main St.
- Worked on repairing storm drain on Church St. Installed new concrete cap and metal grid
- Went to Shelby stone. Picked up crusher run stone. Placed stone down along High St. as edges were high from paving streets.
- Swept up and moved concrete bumpers in front of village hall
- Edged and removed dirt alongside walk going to post office from Pallister Ave.

Water:

- County Health Dept. dropped off bottles and paper work for lead testing samples
- Dig request at 1725 Pallister Ave. Marked out water lines
- Dropped of bottles and paperwork to homeowners, picked up the next morning and took to Niagara Falls lab to be tested.
- Pete Wilson from Mayer Bros. reported to me that he thought water was leaking from ground where it was dup up last winter. Will keep an eye on it.
- Dig request at 8704 High St. – Digging for addition onto house. Water lines were cleared.
- 2nd dig request at 8704 High St. marked in white flags for underground cable. Water was cleared.

Equipment:

- Washed tractors and trucks
- Took Chipper to Bad Monkey's. A few things needed attention.
- Changed oil and filter on B2301 Kubota tractor
- Changed oil and filter on 2015 Chevy truck
- Changed oil and filters on B2301 Kubota tractor transmission and hydraulic
- Cleaned mowing deck and changed blades
- Changed blades on chipper.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage can in both parks weekly
- Mowed and trimmed both parks.
- Replaced broken fence posts on split rail fence at Lake Park.
- Stained split rail fence at lake park
- Sprayed for weeds on both brick sidewalks in Village Park.
- Took pictures of lake erosion from the beach to park edge of bank.

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Attended board meeting
- Took plates off white police car and dropped off at DMV
- Went to Niagara Implement for supplies
- Spoke to person at Town Hall. Gave me a web site to look up application on Municipality owned property with lake erosion.
- Went to Kistner concrete and picked up concrete cap and metal grid for Church St. drain.
- Went to Car Quest and Tractor Supply for supplies
- Met with the Mayor and Paul Chatfield to evaluate lake shore erosion and drainage on Main St.
- Sunrise Door repaired overhead door opener and changed cables on door.
