Streets:

- Mowed road sides, ditches, garage area and East Ave. property
- Watered plants along Main St. and gazebo
- Met with Mike from Midland Asphalt about paving
- Picked up cold patch for more repairs on High St. before paving.
- Put flags up along Main St. and Quaker Rd.
- Chipped brush
- Cleaned out storm drains on both sides of Main St.
- Trimmed and sprayed both sides of bridge on Quaker Rd. going over creek
- Borrowed tractor with sweeper for Town highway dept. Swept High St. to get ready for paving. Also swept East Ave extension going into the Police building.
- High Street was paved. Very happy with the paving job by Midland Asphalt. Big thank you to the Towns of Somerset, Hartland and Newfane for hauling black top to pave High St.

Water:

- Installed new water meter and turned water on at curb box at 1641 Quaker Rd.
- Changed bottom plate on water meter, water was leaking out of the meter at 8736 Quaker Rd.
- Installed new wire to water meter to outside reader at 1875 Quaker Rd.
- Back flow devices inspected at 1663 and 1698 Quaker Rd.
- Met with new owner of 8687 Coleman Rd. He needed a backflow device installed.
- Read water meters for the quarter.
- Dig request at 8713 Main St. – Marked the water lines.
- Re-wired water meter to outside reader at 8514 West Somerset Rd.

Equipment:

- Washed tractors and trucks
- Weed eater repaired at Gordon Fisk's
- Changed blade on mower deck.
- Took salter to Viking in Oakfield and had barrings replaced.
- Drums- Picked up new float and gauge for gas storage tank
- Changed chains on both chain saws.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage can in both parks weekly
- Mowed and trimmed both parks.
- Edged, and mulched around trees, gazebo, bell, and Lion's sign in Village Park
- New sign painted by Mark Weld installed at lake park
- Planted flowers around Lions sign at village park
- Lake park – edged and mulched around gazebo and also edged and mulched along row of bushes.
- Installed and stained new spindles replacing spindles that were broken at Lake Park Gazebo.

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Picked up grass seed and fertilizer at Rhineharts.
- Picked up piece of glass and dropped off storm window frame for Police Station at Standish and Jones.
- Replaced broken glass in window and glazed at Police Building.
