Streets:

- Got barrels from behind the garage, set up in parking lot:
 - Weeded, added topsoil, planted flowers and set barrels along Main St.

Water:

- THM & HAA testing
 - Took samples at 1889 Quaker, The Commons. Took the samples to Niagara Falls Lab to be tested
- Back flow inspection at 1663 Quaker Rd
- Dig request at 1641 Quaker Rd.
 - Located and marked the curb box and service to house

Equipment:
