PUBLIC WORKS REPORT May 2023

Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, garage area, and village hall area
- Picked up brush in dump truck
- Watered flowers along Main Street
- Changed all-way signs at Pallister Avenue and Church Street
- Niagara County Highway department – cut down a couple of Ash trees on Quaker Road

Water:

- Final water read at 8700 Church Street – house sold
- THA and HAA water testing – took water samples at 1889 Quaker Road – took to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- Backflow inspection at 1693 East Avenue
- Dig requests at 1693 Quaker Road, 1695 Quaker Road and 1710 East Avenue – located and marked water
- Backflow inspection at 8698 Coleman Road
- Installed new water meter at 8685 Coleman Road

Equipment:

- Worked on rust – back metal bumper on dump truck
- Changed mower blades, cleaned deck and greased
- Washed both trucks and both tractors

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Raked both parks after cutting grass
- Worked up dirt with rototiller – clock, bell, and memorial areas
- Electricians – village park – replaced three lights on gazebo, fixed outlet and changed eye on lights facing playground
- Pulled weeds and cleaned up around gazebo in village park
- Hung hanging baskets in both gazebos for prom pictures
- Planted flowers in barrels and set along Main Street
- Planted flowers in village park – lions sign, clock, bell, memorial and breaker box – mulched same areas
- Mulched around both gazebos and trees
- Trimmed branches on small trees in village park
- Town helped with mini excavator to remove stumps from tall bushes in front of village gazebo
- Finished putting down wood chips in playground – took left over pile back to the shop
- Lake Shore Tree Service trimmed large tree at lake park and cleaned debris from creek

Other:

- Cut and removed small tree that fell – ditch behind garage
- Trimmed trees and weeds around village hall
- Picked up broken clay pipe and rocks – back of lion's building where new drain was installed
- Picked load of mulch
- Delivered two green garbage carts to 1655 Quaker Road and one cart to 8685 Coleman Road
- Covered office
- Old bank on Main Street – checked location of water meter in basement, removed meter and located service outside by front of bank – town disconnected sewer and NYSEG disconnected gas service – called demo company and gave update
