### **Streets:**

- ✓ Watered plants along Main Street
- ✓ Worked on edging Pallister Avenue to get ready for paving
- ✓ Mowed road sides, ditches and East Avenue property
- ✓ Filled pot holes on Pallister Ave
- ✓ New quotes for side walk-Quaker Road-front of commons to Dollar General
- ✓ Trimmed along Main Street- curb & sidewalk also sprayed for weeds
- ✓ Drove around to check for fallen branches due to high winds
- ✓ Trimmed around street signs & hydrants
- ✓ Chipped brush
- ✓ Trimmed brush at corner of Church Street & Quaker Road that created a blind spot for traffic
- ✓ Removed stone, saw cut & removed broken edges of pavement from water repair at Main Street & East Ave-ready for paving?
