PUBLIC WORKS REPORT August 2024

Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Avenue property and garage area
- Watered plants along Main Street
- Hooked up chipper to dump truck, checked oil and gas and chipped brush
- Leveled dirt and stone where drain was repaired on Quaker Road across from firehall and removed orange barrels
- Trimmed branches on trees along Main Street
- Weeded around hydrants, signs and bridge on Quaker Road

Water:

- THM and HAA water testing – took water samples at 1889 Quaker Road to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- Met with Dan Levy – Nose on the Ground – leak detection with canine

Equipment:

- Picked up new mower blades at Niagara Implements
- Washed both trucks
- Greased fittings on mower deck

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Watered plants in village park
- Cut plants down around sign at lake park
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Pavilion and concrete pad has been completed in village park

Other:

- Wrote monthly reports
- Board meeting
- Cut down small tree on bus garage property
- Took mesh top and side boards off dump truck and picked up load of topsoil
- 1881 East Avenue – worked up lawn where two large areas were dug to check for possible water leaks, rototilled dirt, raked up stone, put topsoil down and seeded
