Streets:

- Reported streetlight outages to Village Hall
- Picked up brush along roadsides from windstorm
- Plowed and salted streets, East Avenue Extension to Village Hall & shoveled & salted steps

Water:

- Final water read at 8715 Main Street
- Shut off water at 1715 Quaker Road
- Final water read at 1701 Pallister Avenue
- Final water read and backflow inspection at 1725 East Avenue
- Straighten curb box at 1732 East Avenue, was bent from property owner-couldn't shut off water because they stainless rod bent inside of curb box- homeowner has water shut off in basement
- Replaced outside reader for water at 8743 Mian Street
- Read water meters for 4th quarter 2021

Equipment:

- Took mowing deck off B2301 tractor, removed brackets that raise and lower deck and front bracket
- Cleaned and greased mowing deck and stored away in metal building
- Pickup truck inspected
- Installed cab on B2301 tractor- installed doors, back window, hooked up fan & wipers, front bracket for snowblower & hooked up snow blower
