Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, Village Hall and garage parking lots
- Salt was delivered and loaded into lean to
- Streetlights are installed and completed
- Pushed back snow piles at the intersections of streets
- Stop sign on the corner of Quaker Road and Church Street was hit by a car- was damaged- placed orange barrel and stop sign temporarily

Water:

- THA & HAA water testing- took water samples at 1887 Quaker Road and delivered the samples to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- County water department called to ask if the snow pile on top of the meter pit on Quaker Road-snow was removed with the tractor

Equipment:

- Emptied salter and rinsed out, washed dump truck, and rinsed off pickup truck and tractors
- Took plow off dump truck and took the dump to Hartway Motors for the recall on the air bags
- Also took pickup truck to Hartway Motors for the recall repair on the air bags
- Greased fittings on L4060 Kubota tractor

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks weekly
- Picked up branches in both parks

Other:

- Drainage work on Lions Club property at 8739 Main Street has been completed by LNR Industries- replaced 60'-70' of clay pipe with black drainage pipe that was blocked by large tree roots- drainage around the Lions building was tied into the large drainage pipe and everything is draining well
- Wrote monthly reports
- Attended Board meeting
- Attended Budget meetings and work to obtain information for budget lines
- Went to the bank for the Village Hall to deposit money
