PUBLIC WORKS REPORT July 2019

Streets:

- Watered plants along Main St.
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Ave property and around garage area
- Borrowed Town Highway Dept sweeper – swept Pallister Ave, corner of Main St and East Ave, and the Village Hall driveway
- Cut down a small tree on Coleman Rd that was blocking the speed limit sign
- Stopped at 1871 Quaker Rd with locator to try and find drainage pipe
- Chipped brush
- Went to Shelby Stone and picked up cold patch and started filling pot holes
- Started edging and clearing up along Pallister Ave – getting ready for paving

Water:

- Dig request – Haight Rd – installing poles for cable lines
- Dig request – 8689 High St – located and marked curb box & water service to house
- Backflow inspection at 8677 Coleman Rd
- Stopped at 1875 Quaker Rd – noise coming from water meter. Install new water meter

Equipment:

- Inspection on dump truck
- B2301 Tractor – leaking hydraulic and transmission fluids. Ordered part from Niagara Implement. Replaced part and added fluid
- Police Car – oil & filter changed, had car looked over
- Power washed mowing deck & engine on B2301 tractor

Parks:

- Mowed & trimmed both parks
- Emptied garbage cans at both parks weekly
- Trimmed low branches in Village Park
- Village Park – Garden Club took two old picnic table and two garbage cans for their Garden Walk
