PUBLIC WORKS REPORT May 2019

Streets:

- Installed post & street signs at Quaker Road & Church Street, also a new sign directing traffic to the new Library location
- Installed sign at West Somerset Road & Quaker Road showing direction for Mayer Brothers traffic
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Ave. property
- Trimmed around street signs & hydrants
- Planted flowers in barrels & set along north side of Main Street
- Swept north side of Main Street –the sidewalk & curb
- Sprayed for weeds, the sidewalk on Main Street

Water:

- Dig request for 1876 Pallister Ave & 8675 High Street & 8734 Main Street & 1677 East Avenue Marked out for water main repair
- Picked up materials for water repairs
- THM & HAA quarterly water samples- Barker Commons, Quaker Road and took to Niagara Falls lab
- Water main repair project- MarWal construction completed the task, which took 3 days to complete-On Main Street cut the tee, plugged & blocked, transferred house services to plastic 8" main-cut 6" cast iron water main on Mayer Brothers property-capped & blocked 6" cast iron- filled all sections dug up with stone-by completing project water leak which had been leaking since January has stopped!!
- Returned extra parts to Lock City Supply
- Filled out credit hours for renewal of Class D water license & obtained renewed license for 3 years
- Final water read at 1713 Pallister Avenue

Equipment:

- Oil & filter changed on the 2015 pick-up truck
- Changed belt on chipper
- Took chipper to Bad Monkeys-replaced fitting on hydraulic line
- Washed trucks & tractors

Parks:

- Mowed & trimmed both parks
- Edged around gazebo, trees & mulched
- Planted flowers around bell, clock, lion's sign & memorial and mulched
- Sprayed for weeds- brick walk ways, hydrant & power poles
- Installed three signs at Lake Park-along the bank of the lake stating Danger Enter At Your Own Risk
