PUBLIC WORKS REPORT February 2023

Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall property, East Avenue, and garage area
- Weeded around street signs, hydrants, intersections, and bridge by firehall
- Sprayed for weeds along sidewalk and curb on Main Street
- HyTech concrete formed and poured sidewalk and curbing for flagpole at new village hall
- Hooked up chipper to dump truck, checked gas and oil – went around and chipped brush
- Planted flowers in barrels and set along Main Street
- Watered plants along Main Street and village park
- Cut low hanging branches that were blocking military banners
- Went around village with Barton and Loguidice – storm drains

Water:

- Leveled and raked up dirt at 1881 East Avenue where possible water leaks were dug up
- THM and HAA water testing – took water samples at 1889 Quaker Road and took to Niagara Falls lab to be tested

Equipment:

- B2601 tractor – cleaned mowing deck, greased fittings, and changed blades on deck
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Ran new ground wire to trailer lights

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Sprayed for weeds around trees, lion sign, clock, bell memorial and breaker box – mulched all areas
- Mulched around trees in village park and did around gazebo and trees at lake park

Other:

- Wrote monthly reports
- Board meeting picked up load of mulch
- Added topsoil to barrels – ready for plating
- Helped Mark Welds mount signs onto new village hall
- Took eighty chairs from metal building to new village hall – took chairs out of boxes, took plastic wrap and Styrofoam off chairs
- Stockam Lumber for supplies
- Moved everything out of old village hall and moved to new village hall

- Helped Hartland Highway Department dig holes, set base to flagpole, mixed concrete and filled base of flagpole
- Took signs and lockbox off of old village hall
