Streets:

- Mowed road sides, ditches, East Ave Property and garage area.
- Chipped brush
- Picked up cold patch at Shelby stone. Went around and filled pot holes in streets
- Trimmed and sprayed around hydrants, signs and ditches.
- Cleaned out storm drains on Pallister Ave and started Quaker Rd.
- Planted flowers in barrels and set along Main St.

Water:

- Turned water on at curb box at 1715 Quaker Rd.
- Checked for backflow devices at 1877 Quaker Rd., 8689 High St. , 1725 Pallister Ave., and 1724 Pallister Ave. These are houses that were sold.
- Meeting at Niagara County water. Re: lead and copper sampling.
- Attended Rural Water Association- Niagara Falls Conference.

Equipment:

- Washed tractors and trucks
- Worked on chipper. Took a part the shoot which was plugged and also drum where blades are.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage can in both parks weekly
- Checked Lake Park due to high water and erosion on Lake Bank.
- Set post and installed sign at Lake Park bank – “No Trespassing- Enter at your own risk” installed. Had to install twice because of erosion of park bank.
- Mowed and trimmed both parks.
- Picked up 5 yards of mulch.
- Took Lake Park sign down and dropped off at Mark Welds.

- Hung baskets in gazebo in Village Park.
- Planted flowers around bell and clock in Village park
- Planted flowers around gazebo at Lake Park.
