Streets:

- Got chipper and dump truck ready – chipped brush
- Watered plants
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Avenue property and garage area
- Picked up barrels along Main Street – pulled plants and stored barrels
- Midland paved East Avenue and Church Street
- O' Regans paved and striped east side east side of Village Hall parking lot
- Hooked up brush hog to tractor and brush hogged ditch on Fels Road

Water:

- Dig request at 1692 Quaker Road – installing new power pole in front of bus garage – located and marked water
- Backflow inspection at 1705 Quaker Road – house being sold
- Dig request at corner of Coleman Road and Quaker Road – County replacing drainage pipe – located and marked water
- Found water leak – service going to 1637 Quaker Road – help from L and R Industries and Town Water Department – dug down to water main on school property – shut corp off to service to 1637 Quaker Road – cut edge of road – dug down to service – there was a hole in copper pipe, cut out section of copper and replaced – service was leaking on village side of curb box – once line was repaired it was quiet on both sides of curb box

Equipment:

- Greased fittings on B2601 tractor
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- New dump truck was delivered

Parks:

- Mowed, weeded, and raked leaves in both parks
- Cut plants down around sign at lake park

Other:

- Board meeting
- Wrote monthly reports
- Changed filters on both heating and cooling units at village hall
- Dropped off orange cones and set up village parking lot for library trunk and treat
- Sanrise Door placed new weather strip on overhead door and programmed two new openers
