## **PUBLIC WORKS REPORT OCTOBER 2016**

### Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Ave. property and around DPW Garage
- Chipped brush for the last time for the season
- Watered plants
- County came down with sweeper- preparing to pave Main St.
- Installed new signs on north and south of Quaker Rd. near Main St. advising that NO trucks are permitted on Main Street.
- Picked up thin layer of old black top on Main St. with tractor.
- Removed flower barrels along Main St. and took back to garage area.
- Took flags down on Quaker Rd. and Main St.
- Met with surveyors- question on drainage on West Somerset and Quaker Rd.
- County paved Main St.
- Picked up orange barrels and cones from Main St.
- Section in front of village hall needed a little attention. – Swept up blacktop and moved concrete bumpers.
- A big thank you needs to go out to – Mike with Somerset, Keith with Hartland, John with Newfane, the Town of Lockport and the County for hauling black top for village paving.
- Wrote down power pole numbers that flags and banners are mounted to on Quaker Rd. and Main St.

### Water:

- Finished exercising water main valves and hydrants.
- Marked area on south side of Main St. by post office for possible water leak – Met with Fred Holley from Rural Water leak detection. Heard nothing leaking on water main.

### Equipment:

- Washed trucks and tractors
- Dump truck – built new sides and cover for chipping. (Made wooden sides that stack on to each other)
- Replaced tail light fixture on trailer.
- Worked on heater at garage. – Relight pilot, checked wiring and fuse was kicked out.

### Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks weekly
- Mowed and trimmed both parks
- Replaced broken fence post at lake park

### Other:

- Wrote monthly report

- Attended NYCOM Public Works training conference
- Met with Dean – He is the new person in charge of Niagara County Highway and met County Commissioner of Public Works.
