Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Ave. property and around DPW Garage
- Chipped brush
- Top soil and seeded where trees were taken down-Pallister Ave. & Church Street
- Met with Craig Smith from Villager-milling company
- Called Mike Tracy from Midland asphalt-asked how much notice they would need to tack coat before paving Main Street-couple of days notice
- County hopefully paving first or second week in October

Water:

- Fred Holly from Rural Water leak detection was out and listened to services at 1706 and 1707 East Avenue-also had Scott Little from Lock City out to listen
- Worked on exercising main water valves and valves to hydrants
- Met with LNR Industries-digging for possible water leak at services 1706 & 1707 East Avenue
 - ✍ Dug to water main
 - ✍ Checked saddles and connections to 1706 & 1707 East Ave
 - ✍ Nothing was leaking
 - ✍ Proceeded to dig up curb box-nothing leaking
 - ✍ Homeowners responsibility to fix service from curb box to house
- Read water meters for the quarter
- Fixed outside reader to water meter at 1715 Pallister Avenue
