Streets:

- ✓ Shelby Stone to pick up a load of crusher run- filled in spots on Main Street & East Avenue after water repairs
- ✓ Watered plants along Main Street
- ✓ Chipped brush
- ✓ Mowed road sides, ditches and East Avenue property
- ✓ County Highway department paved spots on Main Street & East Avenue!!!
- ✓ Removed orange cones & swept corner of Main Street & East Avenue
- ✓ Trimmed around hydrants & street signs

Water:

- ✓ Dig request for 1876 Pallister Avenue-located and marked curb box and water service to the house
- ✓ Re-wired water meter at 1667 Quaker Road in the crawl space to the outside reader
