Streets:

- Raked and cleaned up along road sides from plowing.
- Plowed and salted streets after ice storm – Hopefully for the last time

Water:

- Back flow inspection at 1706 Quaker Rd.
- Checked water pressure at village hall through the day, due to Niagara County water shut down. They were replacing a valve – No change in water pressure
- 1875 Quaker Rd. – replaced water meter and outside reader.

Equipment:

- Power washed plows and Salter twice due to ice storm in mid April. Greased and stored away.
- Installed tail gate to dump truck
- Changed oil and filter on chipper
- Sunrise Door Company repaired opener to overhead door.
- Washed trucks and tractors

Parks:

- Placed garbage cans in parks and village hall
- Installed orange fence to split rail fence at lake park
- Started work on lake park
- Raked and rolled both parks
- Play equipment was delivered and stored in metal building
- Loaded up piece of 18” drain pipe and dropped it off at Lake Park. This was to fix broken drain pipe when contractors are working on Lake shoreline
- Removed wood chips from old playground
- Titan Development installed playground. It is completed. They did a great job.

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Got chipper out of metal building. Rearranged building to make room for playground to be unloaded and stored till it gets installed in park
- Hooked up generator to overhead door in case power went out from ice storm
- Took TV's that were in dumpster and took to Town of Somerset sewer plant drop off.
