Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, village hall parking lot, East Ave. extension to police building and garage parking lot.
- Shoveled and salted walkway and steps in front of Village Hall and Library.
- Pushed back snow piles at village hall parking lot, along park and intersections of streets.
- Removed snow piles from sidewalks on North side of Main St.
- Raked and cleaned up along park from plowing south side of Main St. and end of park by Library.
- Swept debris from plowing along concrete bumpers between Main St. and village hall parking lot. Also straightened bumpers.
- Swept up debris and black top along side of Thee Barker Store on Quaker Rd.
- Went around cleaning out storm drains of debris due to heavy rain.
- Raked and cleaned up intersection of Pallister Ave. and Church St. Also east and west side of Pallister Ave.

Water:

- Took water samples at 1889 Quaker Rd (Commons). – THA and HHA. Dropped off the samples at Niagara Falls lab.

Equipment:

- Emptied salt out of Salter and washed dump truck and pickup truck.
- Removed metal blade on 9 foot snow plow and installed new blade.
- Oil and filter changed on 2015 pickup truck.
- Clean interior of pick up and dump truck.

Parks:

- Took orange fence down at Lake Park and removed posts out of ground. Getting ready for work to be done on Lake shore

Other:

- Picked up supplies at Car Quest and at Tractor Supply
