Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, Village Hall parking lot, East Ave. extension to Police building and garage parking lot.
- Shoveled and salted walkway and steps in front of Village Hall and Library
- Picked up TV on side of road and took to Town sewer plant – electronics drop off

Water:

- 8683 Main St. – repaired water meter. Installed meter to water lines – pipes and bottom plate on meter broke caused by frozen pipes
- Spoke with Paul Chatfield- engineer on water project at end of Main St. and East Ave. Also spoke with him regarding the possibility of some drainage
- Attended Niagara County water – pre-construction meeting- Details on shut down to install valve on existing 30 inch transmission main
- Shut down- notified School and Fire Company
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Emptied salt out of Salter and washed dump truck and pickup truck
- Fixed stainless cover on motor that operates chain conveyor belt on Salter
- Took doors, windows and cab off B2301 tractor
- Took snow blower and mounting bracket for snow blower and stored away
- Took metal brackets off underneath tractor- installed front bracket for mowing deck. Installed deck to tractor to ready for mowing

Parks:

- Spoke to Richard Truesdell- starting boulders on Lake Park bank the first week in April. First week will be hauling boulders. Following week with start setting boulders along Lake Park bank
- Emptied garbage can at Lake Park

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Worked on and completed budget for the new fiscal year
- Painted shelving and brackets. Installed them to make additional shelving space in fire proof room at Village Hall
- Went to Standish and Jones for supplies
- Painted brackets that held flower boxes in front of village hall
- Spread stone at public works garage from plowing
