## Streets:

- ✓ Watered plants along Main St. and in park.
- ✓ Met with Jack Feltz from Forestry at National Grid. They cut down 3 trees at 1716 Pallister Ave. and one in the Village Park.
- ✓ Jack Feltz also said he could assist with other trees in the green spaces.
- ✓ Installed new welcome signs on to posts.
- ✓ Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Ave. property and garage area.
- ✓ Chipped brush
- ✓ Cleaned up broken glass on Quaker Rd. and Main St.

## Water:
