PUBLIC WORKS REPORT AUGUST 2016

Streets:

- Worked on cleaning up fine millings on north and south side of Main Street and curbs
- Repaired storm drains on Main Street- before paving
- County will be paving Main Street sometime in September
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, East Avenue property and garage area
- Chipped brush
- Borrowed sweeper from Town Highway Department raining- cleaned up loose gravel and picked up pile with loader
- Cleaned up stump grindings on Church Street and Pallister Avenue

Water:

- Took water samples- THM & HAA at commons on Quaker Road- took to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- Final water reading at 1643 Quaker Road
- Locate curb box and water service to house at 1717 Pallister Avenue- replacing front porch & holes being dug
- Dig request-located and marked water main & service to Yorker House due to stump grinding and sewer repair
- Turned water on at 8736 Main Street
- Located and marked curb box & service and water main at 1707 East Avenue- owner thinks there is a leak- Fred Holly from Rural Water is coming out September 6th to check on leak, as well as Scott Little from Lock City is coming out September 8th

Equipment:

- 200 hour service on B2301 Kubota Tractor
- Washed both trucks and tractors

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans weekly in both parks
- Bee problem at Lake Park- bees were coming from underneath gazebo floor-exterminator came out to remove nest and spray
- Exterminator came out to recheck the bee problem and spray again 8/29
- Mowed and trimmed both parks
- Trimmed and sprayed weeds on brick sidewalks in park and finished Main Street sidewalks on North Side
- Cleaned up stump grindings on trees at the Lake Park

Other:

- Wrote monthly report
- Signed letters to Towns that helped supply trucks for the Milling of Main Street
- Picked up TV on side of the road in the Village and dropped it off at the Town's electronic recycling
- Filled in pot holes with gravel picked up from Main Street at garage parking lot and some in bus garage driveway
