Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, Village Hall, and garage areas.
- Watered plants along Main St.
- Sprayed for weeds on the North side of Main St. along the curb and sidewalk as well as the south side curb and brick walkways in the park.
- Checked storm drains around the village due to heavy rains.
- Picked up brush around town in the dump truck.
- Cut and removed a large branch that fell across Church St.
- Main St. and East Ave. Marked location of storm drain repair. Called for a dig request. Digging is postponed until the drains are pumped dry and can be scoped. We are borrowing scope from Middleport DPW.

Water:

- One dig request: 1677 East Ave. Located and marked curb boxes at each location.
- Backflow device inspection at 1682 and 1684 Quaker, 8681 High St, and 1723 Pallister Ave. Property being listed for sale.
- Final water reading at 1723 Pallister Ave.
- Re-read water meters that had abnormally high readings.

Equipment:

- Cleaned underneath mowing deck and changed the cutting blades.
- Washed both trucks and the tractors.
- Performed the 400hr service on L4060 tractor. Changed the oil and filter, transmission and hydraulic oil and filters.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks weekly.
- Trimmed weeds and mowed both parks.
- Village Park Gazebo Replaced boards on the steps, scraped and cleaned, and have begun staining. Trimmed the bushes around the outside.
- Lake Park- filled in hole with topsoil & seeded.
- Watered plants.
