Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, garage area and village hall area
- Finished filling in potholes with cold patch
- Picked up brush around village in dump truck
- Weeded around hydrants, signs, and ditches around village
- Weeded and sprayed weeds along north side of Main Street swept and cleaned up along curb and sidewalk

Water:

- Checked on a few water reads from quarterly readings
- Located and marked water services for dig request at 8707 and 8680 Coleman Road
- Called Rural Water to set up appointment to come out for possible leak detection

Equipment:

- Had repairs on dump truck done at Hartway Motors was running rough and missing points and plugs
- Took mower blades to Gordon Fisk to be sharpened
- Detailed inside of pickup truck and L4060 tractor
- Greased fittings on L4060 tractor
- Changed blades on mower deck
- Washed trucks and tractors

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks (weekly)
