Streets:

- Went around and filled pot holes on all Village streets with cold patch
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall property on East Avenue and garage area
- Watered plants on Main Street
- Trimmed around signs, hydrants & along bridge railings on Quaker Road
- Hooked up brush hog to tractor and cut ditch off of Fels Road
- Went around unclogging storm drains of debris from heavy rains
- Met with LNR Industries and worked with Nick to repair storm drain that caused a sink hole on edge of Quaker Road across from the Fire Hall
- Blocked off Main Street and set orange cones up at Village Hall parking lot for Corn fest

Water:

- 1879 Pallister Avenue- checked pipe near house because the owners were digging from the house to the road. The pipe was for their sump pump to drain to the edge of the road
- Dig Request-1669 Quaker Road repaving of parking lot- located curb box and marked in blue paint

Equipment:

- B2601 Tractor- changed oil and filter, cleaned mowing deck and greased fittings
- Washed both tractors and trucks

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Mowed and trimmed both parks
- Watered plants
- Trimmed bushes, pulled weeds, edged & mulched around the Gazebo
- Went over layout of Corn Fest with Hedi in Main Street Park and Main Street
