### STREETS:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, garage area and East Ave. property
- Watered plants along Main St., village hall and parks on a daily basis.
- Picked up cold patch at Shelby Stone and filled in pot holes in streets
- Closed Main St. on a Sunday for an Optimist Club event
- Installed box on to the dump truck, hooked up chipper and chipped brush.
- Trimmed and sprayed ditches along Quaker Rd. and Coleman Rd.
- Repaired flags on power poles that had come down due to high winds.
- Milled Main St.

### WATER

- Picked up a one inch meter at Lock City.
- Our Lady of the Lake Parish Church meter needs to be replaced. Outside reader is lagging.
- Located and marked curb box at 1705 Quaker Rd. and 8690 Coleman Rd.
- Started exercising main valves and painting curb boxes.
- Opened fittings on hydrants and put anti-seize on treads.

### EQUIPMENT:

- Repaired water wagon
- Greased fittings on box to dump truck
- Tom Hicks from Bentley visited and went over new tractor.
- Detailed inside of pickup truck
- Changed blades on chipper
- Took B2301 tractor to Bentleys. The mowing deck still drops.

### PARKS

- Emptied garbage cans weekly in both parks
- Trimmed and mowed both parks
- Edged, weeded, trimmed bushes, mulched around gazebo in Village Park (Main St). – Also memorial area, small trees, bell and clock areas.
- Damage to village park – Graffiti on gazebo and broken ornamental bracket. Stained over graffiti and repaired bracket.
- New bolts on slide at playground.
