## **PUBLIC WORKS REPORT** June 2024

### **Streets:**

- Cut low hanging branches on Church Street because buses were hitting them. Chipped up branches and cut low branches at Pallister Avenue and High Street.
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall property on East Avenue and garage area
- Watered plants on Main Street
- Sprayed for weeds along sidewalk (north side of Main Street)
- Met with surveyors from Barton and Loguidice – helped with locations of storm drains
- Trimmed branches and vines at the corner of Church Street and Quaker Road
- Went to Shelby store and picked up load of cold patch
- Met with county highway about sink hole in front of 1663 Quaker Road – drainage pipe possibly collapsed. County marked spot and called in dig request.
- Chipped brush

### **Water:**

- Three dig requests – two at 1028 Quaker Road – and one at 1663 Quaker Road. Located and marked water lines
- Met with Kevin Miller from leak detection – checked sink hole in front of 1663 Quaker Road – no leak detected
- Backflow inspection at 8690 Coleman Road
- Read meters for the quarter

### **Equipment:**

- Tightened belt to alternator on chipper
- Washed both tractors and trucks
- Picked up part at Niagara Implement – B2611 tractor
- Cleaned deck and changed blades on B2601 tractor
- Gordon Fisk – picked up gas hedge trimmers – had repairs done

### **Parks:**

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Watered plants

### **Other:**

- Picked up cardboard and boxes from new village hall board room and from the front of the library – took to dumpster
- Board meeting

- Met with Bedford Blacktop and R and M Paving for estimates to pave east side of new village hall
- Picked up cabinet at 111 Clinton Street in Lockport for village hall
- Took folding tables back to firehall

- Electrician finished conduit to flagpole at village hall. Filled in curbing with dirt, planted flowers and mulched
