Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, ditches, Village Hall, and garage areas.
- Removed light string from the tree in front of Thee Barker Store on Main St.
- Watered plants along Main St.
- Sprayed for weeds on the North side of Main St. along the curb and sidewalk.
- Attached chipper to the dump truck and chipped brush around the Village.

Water:

- Took water samples for THA & HAA water testing and sent them to the Niagara Falls lab.
- Four dig requests: 1889 Quaker, 1726 Pallister Ave., 8708 Main St., and 8704 High St. Located and marked curb boxes at each location.
- Backflow device inspection at 1700 Pallister Ave. Property being listed for sale.

Equipment:

- Cleaned underneath mowing deck and greased fittings.
- Washed both trucks and the tractors.

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks - weekly.
- Trimmed weeds and mowed both parks.
- Removed a section of fence at the Lake Park for the tree service contractors to get through to remove two trees.
- Lake Shore Tree Service contracted to remove two trees and grind the stumps at the Lake Park.
- Planted flowers and placed mulch around the bell, clock, and memorial in the Village Park.

Other:

- Wrote monthly reports.
- Attended the work session.
- Located a leak in the roof at the Village Hall. Patched and tarred the hole.
- Cut up a fallen tree, removed debris, and mowed the ditch behind the garage.
- Went to Standish Jones for supplies.
- Purchased five yards of mulch.
- Purchased flowers for the barrels on Main St. and both parks.
- Delivered a recycle bin to 1727 Quaker Rd.
