### **Streets:**

- Brush/Chipping/Lawn:
  - Removed barrels along Main St. and pulled plants. Stored barrels for the winter.
  - Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall, and garage areas.

  - Removed brush hog, serviced, and stored for the winter months.
  - Trimmed low hanging branches around town in preparation for snow removal.
  - Cut down and removed tree that fell along the ditch behind the garage.
