Streets:

- Sprayed for weeds:
 - Main St. - north side curb and sidewalk, and along south side curb.
- Brush/Chipping/Lawn:
 - Watered plants on Main St.
 - Mowed roadsides, ditches, village hall, and garage areas.
 - Trimmed weeds around hydrants, street signs, and ditches.

Water:

- Dig Requests - Located and marked water services:
 - 8700 Church St.
- Replaced water meter and outside reader at 1674 Quaker Rd.
- Read meters for quarterly billing.

Equipment/ DPW:

- Changed blades on mowing deck.
- Changed the belt on chipper.

Parks:
