Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, garage area and village hall area
- Went around village and weeded around signs, hydrants, intersections, ditches in front of Dollar General and along railing over creek on Quaker Road
- Got chipper and dump truck ready – chipped brush

Water:

- Met with Nick from LNR Industries – questions on lead service at 1713 Quaker Road and drain pipe at 8702 High Street
- Backflow device inspection at 1710 Quaker Road
- Met with Kevin Miller from Rural Water for leak detection – went around and listened to all hydrants in the village – last hydrant he listened to was leaking – got wrench onto valve and hydrant stopped leaking – will need to be repaired in the near future
- Did lead and copper testing samples at 1713 Quaker Road, 8516 West Somerset Road and 8690 Coleman Road – took samples to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- Installed new water meter at 8655 Woodward Avenue and inspected back flow device
- Turned water on at meter pit at 1695 East Avenue – back buildings behind Hideaway bar
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Checked oil and gas in chipper
- Took brush hog off of tractor and stored away in metal building
- Changed mower blades and cleaned underneath mowing deck
- Took blades to Gordon Fisks to be sharpened

Parks:

- Emptied garbage weekly in both parks
- Watered plants in village park
- Mowed and weeded both parks
- Trimmed branches on trees in village park

Other:

- Wrote monthly reports
- Board meeting
- Loaded tires from garage and dropped off at Town Highway garage
- Had keys made up for new village hall

- Picked up blades at Gordon Fisks
- Old bank on Main Street – demo completed, leveled, topsoil and hydroseeded
